The nuances of language! What is the subtle difference between the questions 'Do you have a Growth Mindset?' and 'Are you in a Growth Mindset?' This was just one of the things that got Yinnar staff thinking about the power of language for developing and growing learners on our professional learning day with James Nottingham. In answer to the questions, it is worth understanding that we can be in either a fixed mindset or in a growth mindset. Everyone, at times, will be in one mindset or another but some people may be more often in either one. A very small percentage of people, if any, remain in one mindset only. We will only learn to our **full** potential when we are in a growth mindset. The challenge is to coach ourselves into one.

The day was fabulous for building on our previous understanding of how to create challenge in learning. James coached our thinking on the power of dialogue to promote thinking skills. Throughout the day we found ourselves using the language of thinking and of learning

and discovering how subtle differences in words like 'all' or 'many' can challenge thinking. We were challenged all day. We found ourselves challenging each other. Challenge is highly engaging!

We are looking forward to continuing to challenge our learners and helping them to spend more learning time in a growth mindset.
