Enrolment POLICY

Purpose

To ensure that all students have access to a neighbourhood school and the freedom to choose other schools subject to individual enrolment policies.

Policy

Children of school age have the right to be admitted to their designated neighbourhood government school at the beginning of the school year (or when relevant) unless an approved alternative placement has been arranged.

The Regional Director has the authority to effect placement of students.

Designated Neighbourhood School

The Designated Neighbourhood School is the school that is nearest the student's permanent residence, as measured by the shortest practical route as per DET software, unless the regional director:

- needs to restrict new enrolments at a school or;
- has designated the Neighbourhood Boundaries for the school.

Priority Order of Placement

Enrolments will be accepted subject to meeting the following criteria:

- Students who live in the allocated catchment provided by the DET Designated Neighbourhood Boundary.
- Students who have siblings already attending Yinnar PS.

Discretionary Placement

- Enrolments directed by Regional Director
- If places exist up to classroom size thresholds for students as determined by the principal
- In exceptional circumstances, students may be enrolled where there are significant extenuating family or individual circumstances

Capacity of the school to enrol students across year levels will be assessed at December 1st for the future school year

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three-year review cycle.
